## **How the Caswell County Partnership for Children is positively affecting Caswell County's businesses:**

- Dependable child care reduces employee absenteeism and tardiness
- Dependable child care increases employee morale
- Increased number of child care spaces provides more child care options for employees
- Child care facilities extending morning and evening hours gives employees more flexibility with shift and weekend hours
- Improvement in child care teacher retention provides the children with more stability and therefore more stable employees
- Dental and vision screenings provided at child care facilities help prevent children's health problems and therefore reduce employee absenteeism and tardiness
- Family support services and respite care improves employee morale and reduces employee absenteeism and tardiness
- Transportation provided to families and children to child care and health sites reduces employee absenteeism and tardiness
- Assistance with child care costs provides more child care options for employees
- Child Care Resource and Referral service provides direct child care information to parents which reduces employee absenteeism and tardiness
- Early intervention services and developmental screenings potentially reduces future employee absences by preventing future health problems
- The Support Our Students after school tutoring program prepares a more intelligent and responsible workforce for the near future
- The Adolescent Pregnancy Program provides a more stable and responsible workforce for the near future
