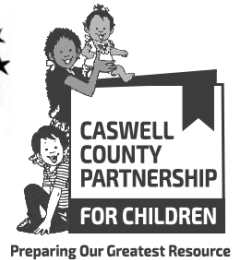


2019-2020 Caswell County NC Pre-Kindergarten Services Information



What is NC Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K)?

The Caswell County NC Pre-K Program provides quality educational experiences in order to enhance kindergarten readiness for eligible four-year-olds. Pre-K classrooms operate at least six hours a day, Monday through Friday from late August – June. The program is free to qualifying families. NC Pre-K classes are located at Caswell Community Head Start and Caswell County Schools (North, Oakwood, and South Elementary Schools). By submitting a NC Pre-K application, your child will be considered for all possible placements. Please check your first choice for site placement on the NC Pre-K application. Completing an application does not guarantee participation in the NC Pre-K program.

Each site has different eligibility criteria:

- Caswell Community Head Start prioritizes children following Head Start guidelines.
- Caswell County School sites prioritize children who have the greatest educational need, as determined through the pre-school screenings. To have your child screened contact the elementary school in your district.

Should I apply? In order to apply to the Caswell County NC Pre-K Program, your child must be:

Other factors that may be used to determine if your child is eligible include:

| • Having an IEP (Individualized Education Program) or an identified educational need | • Speaking limited or no English in the home |
